Count items received FROM other Missouri Evergreen Libraries (ME Borrowers)

Purpose of the Report

This report was created to allow libraries to see how many items have been transited as holds from one specified library to another within a given time frame. The most common use for this report would be to run the template with all your library locations selected in the “Destination Library” filter to see how many items you’ve borrowed from ME libraries.

Running the Template

1. Enter a unique title in the “Report Name” field.

2. Select the folder where you wish to save the report.

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3. Select the time frame you want the report to include.

4. Select the library and branches you would like the report to include as the Owing Library (you can select multiple by holding the ctrl button while clicking).

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5. Select the type of output you want to receive in the end.

6. Select the folder where you wish the output file to be saved.

1. Navigate to the folder where you saved the output.
2. Check the box next to your report.

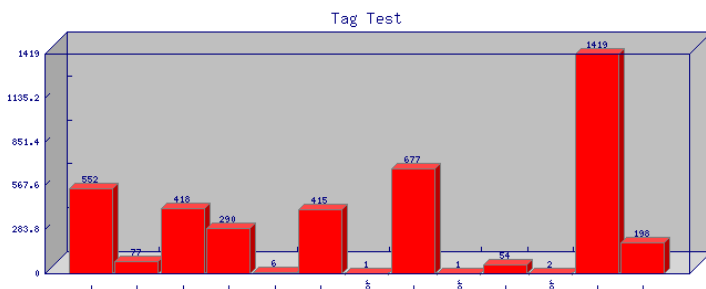
3. Select "View Report" from the drop-down menu above and click Submit.

 - a. If you choose "Excel output," you'll then have to open the output file once it has finished downloading.

Understanding and Using the Report Output

The output of this report is fairly straightforward with only two columns, Owning Library and Transit ID. The Transit ID is the number of items that were owned by the owning library that had the other library listed as the destination.

As with any count report output, it's important to remember that each row of the output table counts only items that match one another in each of the other columns. With this in mind, it's often necessary to do some manipulation of the data after the report is run to combine the counts of multiple rows in order to achieve a total that is useful and accurate.
