Responsibilities include:

- Cataloger Biennial Certification
 - In concert with the cataloging committee, create a certification process for ME catalogers
 - Perform cataloging duties (importing, overlaying, etc.) at the request and on behalf of Level 2 catalogers or libraries with restricted permissions as necessary.
- Training
 - Create and provide cataloging training to member libraries through in-person visits, instructional videos and documents, and any other necessary methods
 - Provide cataloging support and explain Missouri Evergreen cataloging procedures and policies to migrating libraries
 - o Work with new migrating libraries' catalogers on additional questions
- Cataloging Committee
 - Serve on the cataloging committee and attend all committee meetings
 - Answer questions and notify catalogers about additional resources, training opportunities, etc.
- Catalog Cleanup
 - Oversee and contribute to catalog cleanup.
 - Assist with completing larger cleanup projects (parts assignment, deduplication, etc.)
 - Identify and communicate cataloging issues or errors, whether at the consortium or individual library level.
 - Address any updates that may affect cataloging and notify member libraries of any changes in information to cataloging policies, Best Practices, or other procedures.
